- 3. I have provided Letters of Recommendation (in the scholarship application).
- 4. I will be attending a **college, university, or post-secondary institution** in the Fall of 2023.

Teddy J. Purcell Memorial Scholarship

Provides scholarships to Faith Family Academy high school graduating seniors who have **attended FFA for the previous 4 years, are 1st Generation College Students**, and are pursuing a post-high school course of study at a **FOUR-YEAR UNIVERSITY. Must check all to be eligible:**


- 1. I am a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 2. I have demonstrated community involvement (in the scholarship application).
- 3. I have provided Letters of Recommendation (in the scholarship application).
- 4. I will be attending a **FOUR-YEAR university** in Fall 2023.
- 5. I have **attended Faith Family Academy the previous FOUR (4) years** (9th thru 12th grades).
- 6. I am a **1st generation college attendee (not including siblings)**.

Trey H. Phillips Memorial Scholarship:

Provides scholarships to Faith Family Academy high school graduating seniors pursuing post-high school course of study at either a **technical or trade school/program/certifications. Must check all to be eligible:**

- 1. I am a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 2. I have demonstrated community involvement (in the scholarship application).
- 3. I have provided letters of recommendation (in the scholarship application).
- 4. I will be attending a **Technical or Trade School, certification program** in the Fall of 2023.

***NOTE: Scholarship funds will only be awarded
upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.***

Application Process:

1. **Submit application No Later Than 4:00pm, Monday, *March 06, 2023.***
Finalists will be interviewed by Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarship Committee Members in April 2023.
2. **Scholarships will be awarded during Faith Family Academy Graduation ceremonies on May 27, 2023.**

Application Submission:

1. Completed **Scholarship Application Form** (if handwritten, please print legibly in black ink).
2. **Letter of Application & Personal Essay** addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information, as well as a short answer to the personal essay question.
3. Three (3) **Letters of Recommendation** from your choice of high school teachers, staff, employers, and/or individuals with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
4. An **official, spring 2023 high school transcript** with GPA and a class standing/rank.
5. **SIGNED STATEMENT BY STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN(S) ON ACCURACY & ACCEPTANCE OF SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS PAGE 8.**

1. DEADLINE for ALL scholarship applications is **Monday, March 06, 2023, by 4:00 p.m. (No exceptions).**
2. Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline will **NOT** be considered.
3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please note "N/A" in the answer space provided or the application could be considered incomplete.
4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be returned to you for correction or disqualified.

Letter of Application & Personal Essay addressed to the Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarship Committee. This should be on a separate page. This essay should be 1-2 pages. The essay should:

- Tell the scholarship committee about yourself;
- Tell the scholarship committee about future college and career goals;
- Share how scholarship funding will make a difference in your life, and how it will help you.

The essay should answer the following questions:

1. What are your educational and professional goals for college?
2. What community service activities, hobbies, outside interests and extracurricular activities did you participate in during high school?
3. How did you show leadership or grow as a person by participating in these activities?
4. How did you have a positive impact on individuals or community?
5. What honors or awards have you receive as a result of the activities you participated in?
6. What one (1) example would show you have the commitment and dedication to succeed in college?

The Faith Family Education Foundation is implementing requirements for the 2021-2022 School Year. This includes the Teddy J. Purcell Scholarship, Trey H. Phillips Scholarship, Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarships.

To receive scholarship funds:

1. **You agree to the following Scholarship Acceptance Conditions:-**
2. You will **follow the Scholarship Acceptance Process**; and
3. You have disclosed all government/college financial assistance which you have applied for and you will or you have already received.

I. Scholarship Acceptance Conditions

A. Use of Funds.

- Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarship (FFEFS) funds are awarded to pay for tuition. Books will be paid for only if funds remain after payment is made towards the tuition bill. Funds will ONLY be made available with proof of enrollment and tuition bill for the current semester and class schedule.
- You must be enrolled at a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution, or technical/trade school (see below) to receive scholarship funds.
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to your college/university or other post-secondary educational institution, or technical/trade school.
- Scholarship funds will not be paid directly to an individual student.

B. Institution Change. Scholarships are awarded based upon attendance at the desired institutions stated level of higher education, as indicated in scholarship applications and interviews, e. g. 4-year, 2-year, or Trade/Technical School attendance.

- If scholarship funds have been awarded based upon stated attendance at a 4-year institution, and you attend a 4-year institution, the full scholarship amount will be awarded.
- However, **IF YOU SWITCH FROM A 4-YEAR INSTITUTION TO A 2-YEAR INSTITUTION OR TRADE/TECHNICAL SCHOOL, YOUR SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE FORFEITED.**
- If there are extenuating circumstances regarding a change from a 4-year to 2-year institution or to a trade/technical school, scholarship recipients may **APPEAL** the decision to the **FFEF Scholarship Committee**.

C. Scholarship Term. Scholarship funds are intended to be utilized during **the school year following the award, with concurrent enrollment in Fall/Spring Semesters**, e. g. Fall of 2023 and Spring of 2024.

- The initial withdrawal of the Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarship monies **MUST** be utilized **no later than Fall 2023**.
- **A scholarship awardee must claim the Faith Family Education Foundation Scholarship by August 15, 2023** or have made arrangements with Dr. Amanda Subjinski to discuss the extenuating circumstances for a possible extension.
- **Subject to the Carryover Provisions below, funds will be forfeited if not used beginning in the Fall 2022.**

- D. **Carryover Provisions.** Funds are allowed to be carried over in certain limited circumstances:
- If the scholarship awardee has completed both semesters of the prior school year, but tuition costs have not fully utilized all monies, remaining funds may be rolled over to the following Summer Semester. Any remaining funds will be forfeited.
 - Summer sessions may be utilized for any balance of funds providing recipient has successfully completed the previous Spring semester.
- E. **Conditions for Modification or Revocation of Scholarship.** The Scholarship Committee maintains the right to revoke or modify the scholarship award if any scholarship acceptance requirements are not met.

II. **Scholarship Acceptance Process**

- Once you have a tuition statement on your account, please email a copy of your registration and tuition statements to Dr. Amanda Subjinski @ asubjinski@faithfamilyacademy.org.
- Your submitted copy of registration and tuition statements may NOT be a photo.
- **YOU MUST SUBMIT REGISTRATION (Class schedule) AND TUITION STATEMENTS AT LEAST 72 HOURS BEFORE THE TUITION DEADLINE OR WE CANNOT GUARANTEE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE BY THE DEADLINE.**
- Once Dr. Subjinski has verification that you have registered, she will work to have the scholarship payment issued to your school to be applied to your tuition for Fall 2023. If there are remaining funds, they will be applied to the following semester.
- The scholarship payment will only be sent to your school to be applied to tuition. **We will not issue additional payment/s once your tuition and/or books have been paid.**
