- 1. Completed Scholarship Application Form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Letter of Application & Personal Essay addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information, as well as a short answer to the personal essay question.
- 3. At least two (2) Letters of Recommendation from your choice of college professors, employers, coaches, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official, recent college transcript with GPA.

- 1. DEADLINE for ALL scholarship applications is 4:00 p.m., Monday, March 6, 2023. (No exceptions).
- 2. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the appropriate space.
- 4. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will result in your being disqualified. PLEASE USE BLACK OR BLUE INK, NOT PENCIL.

## THE JANICE VARNELL ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

# PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. FOLLOWING ARE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2023 JANICE VARNELL ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP. YOU NEED TO SIGN THE FORM AT THE END OF THIS DOCUMENT AS A PART OF THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION.

The Faith Family Education Foundation is implementing requirements for the 2022-2023 School Year.

To receive scholarship funds:

- 1. You agree to the following Scholarship Acceptance Conditions, and
- 2. You will **follow the <u>Scholarship Acceptance Process</u>**, as listed below.

### I. Scholarship Acceptance Conditions

### A. Use of Funds.

- The Janice Varnell Alumni Scholarship funds are awarded to pay for tuition and/or books only. No funds will be made available without proof of enrollment for the current semester.
- You must be enrolled at a college/university or other post-secondary educational institution, or technical/trade school (see below) to receive scholarship funds.
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to your college/university or other post-secondary educational institution, or technical/trade school.
- Scholarship funds will not be paid directly to an individual student.

- B. **Institution Change.** Scholarships are awarded based upon stated level of institution higher education attendance, as indicated in scholarship applications and interviews, e. g. 4-year, 2-year, or Trade/Technical School attendance.
  - o If scholarship funds have been awarded based upon stated attendance at a 4-year institution, and you attend a 4-year institution, the full scholarship amount will be awarded.
  - O However, IF YOU SWITCH FROM A 4-YEAR INSTITUTION TO A 2-YEAR INSTITUTION OR TRADE/TECHNICAL SCHOOL, YOUR SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE FORFEITED.
  - If there are extenuating circumstances regarding a change from a 4-year to 2-year institution or to a trade/technical school, scholarship recipients may APPEAL the decision to the FFEF Scholarship Committee.
- C. **Scholarship Term.** Scholarship funds are intended to be utilized during **the school year following the award, with concurrent enrollment in Fall/Spring Semesters**, e. g. Fall of 2023 and Spring of 2024.
  - The Janice Varnell Alumni Scholarship MUST be utilized no later than Fall 2023.
  - A scholarship awardee must claim the Janice Varnell Alumni Scholarship by August 15, 2023 or have made arrangements with Dr. Amanda Subjinski to discuss the extenuating circumstances.
  - Subject to the Carryover Provisions below, funds will be forfeited if not used beginning in the Fall 2023.
- D. Carryover Provisions. Funds are allowed to be carried over in certain limited circumstances:
  - If the scholarship awardee has completed both semesters of the prior school year, but tuition and/or book costs have not been fully utilized, any remaining funds may be rolled over to the following Summer Semester until funds have been exhausted.
  - Summer sessions may be utilized for any balance of funds providing recipient has successfully completed the previous Spring semester.

### II. Scholarship Acceptance Process

- Once you have a tuition statement on your account, please email a copy of your registration and tuition statements to Dr. Amanda Subjinski. <u>foundation@faithfamilyacademy.org</u>. Dr. Subjinski may need access to your online account to make payment or a check will be mailed to the institution.
- Your submitted copy of registration and tuition statements may NOT be a photo. (PDF)
- YOU MUST SUBMIT REGISTRATION AND TUITION STATEMENTS AT LEAST 72 HOURS BEFORE THE TUITION DEADLINE OR WE CANNOT GUARANTEE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE BY THE DEADLINE.
- Once Dr. Subjinski has verification that you have registered, she will issue the scholarship payment to your school to be applied to your tuition and/or books for Fall 2021. If there are remaining funds, they will be applied to the following semester/s for tuition and/or books.
- The scholarship payment will only be sent to your school to be applied to tuition and/or books.
   We cannot issue payment once your tuition and/or books have been paid.
